Subject: Grant of Dearness Allowance to the State Government employees, Teachers & Nonteaching employees of Non-Govt. Educational Institutions/ Employees of Statutory Bodies/Govt. Undertakings/Panchayats including Panchayat Karmee and Municipal Corporation/Local Bodies etc. who are drawing their pay in the pre-revised scale w.e.f. 01.12.2010.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department Order No. 10902-F (P) dated 09.12.2009 and No. 2582-F (P) dated 06.04.2010 revising the Dearness Allowance with effect from 01.12.2009 and 01.04.2010 respectively is respect of the State Government employees/ Teachers & Non-teaching employees of Non-Govt, Educational Institutions/Employees Statutory Bodies/Govt. Undertakings/panchayats including Panchayat Karmee and Municipal Corporation/ Local Bodies etc. w.e.f. December 01,2009 who are drawing their pay in the pre-revised scale.

The rates of Dearness Allowance to above categories of employees shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 73% to 87% with effect from 01.12.2010. All other conditions as laid down in 10902-F dated 09.12.2009 will continue to apply.

The Dearness Allowance sanctioned here-in-above shall be rounded off to the nearest rupee in each case.

It has also been decided that allowance of the Public Undertakings/Statutory Bodies the additional expenditure should be borne by such Undertakings/Bodies themselves out of their own resources or out of financial assistance provided to them in the budget and that no additional financial assistance will be given to them on account of sanction of Dearness Allowance.
