**MEMO**

***Sub: Merger of 50% Dearness Allowance/Dearness Relief with Basic Pay/ Pension w.e.f. April 01, 2007 Clarification Regarding Regulation of N.P.P. in case of Medical Officers.***

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Deptt's Memo No. 2415-F & 2416-F dt. 27.03.2007 on the above mentioned subject and to say that subsequent to issue of these orders question has been raised as to whether 50% N.P.P. along with 50% of Basic pay shall be treated as Dearness Pay. 2. After careful consideration of the matter the Governor has been pleased to decide that in partial modification of this Deptt. Memo No. 2415-F & 2416-F dt. 27.03.2007 50% of Basic Pay and N.P.P. taken together shall be converted as Dearness Pay and shown distinctly as Dearness Pay (D.P.) which would be counted for the purpose of Payment of Dearness Allowance only. It is further clarified that Dearness Pay shall not be taken into account for the purpose of computation of N.P.P. Further more, Dearness Pay and N.P.P. w.e.f. 01.04.2007 in case of Medical Officers shall be payable as per illustration below:-

It is further clarified that Dearness Pay as sanctioned in G.O. No. 2415-F dt 27.03.2007 will be rounded off to the nearest rupee in each case.
