The question of allowing the benefit of connotation of half-pay leave to the teachers and non-teaching employees of Government Schools upto a maximum of 60 days on private affairs which has been allowed to the teachers and non-teaching employees of non-Government Schools during the entire period of service in School or Schools has been under consideration of this Department for some time past.

- 2) After careful consideration of the matter, the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor has been pleased to decide that the teachers and non-teaching employee of these Government Schools may be allowed to enjoy commuted leave subject to the following conditions.
  - i) half-pay leave upto a maximum of 60 days may be allowed to be commuted on private affairs during the entire period of service in School or Schools;
  - ii) Commuted leave on medical certificate which is admissible under rule 173(3) of W.B.S.R.-I shall, however, continue to be granted as usual;
  - iii) When commuted leave is so granted, twice the amount of such leave will be debited against the half-pay leave due.
- 3) Necessary amendments in the relevant rules will be made in due course.
- 4) This order will take effect from 1st July, 1995.
