## Sub: Grant of Dearness Relief of retired Judicial Officers of the Govt. of West Bengal.

In continuation of this Office Circular No. Pen Co-ordn./65 Vol. IV/24 dt. 18/05/2009 it is stated that the Govt. of West Bengal Judicial Department vide their circular letter No. 7331-J dt. 4-11-2009 have revised the rate of dearness relief to 73% w.e.f 01-07-2009 payable on basic pension/family pension and dearness pension/dearness family pension taken together to the retired Judicial officers including members of Higher Judical Service of the State of West Bengal.

- 2. Payment of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
- 3. It shall be responsibility of the Pension Disbursing Authority including nationalized Banks etc. to calculate the quantum of dearness relief payable in each individual case.
- 4. All concerned Pension Disbursing Authorities are therefore requested to make necessary arrangements for payment of dearness relief to the above categories of pensioners/family pensioners (i.e. retired Judicial officers including members of Higher Judicial Service of the State of West Bengal at the rate of 73% w.e.f 01-07-2009 after proper adjustment.
