Sub: Enhancement of rate of daily wages for casual workers.

Sir,

Consequent upon the revision of Dearness Allowance to whole-time Government employees with effect from 01-11-98, the question of revision of the rates of daily wages for casual workers on 'no work no pay' basis engaged in different Government offices was under active consideration of the Government.

2) After careful consideration of all aspects of the matter, the Governor has been pleased to decide that for daily rated workers under the government whose wages are not regulated by any of the statutory provisions like the Minimum wages act etc. there will a further ad-hoc increase in their existing daily rate of wages by Rs. 6 (Rupees six) only with effect from 01-11-98.

The revised rates of daily wages for different categories of casual worker with effect from 01.11.98 will be as follows:

Group-D	71.81
Drivers	81.60
Group-C/L.D.C./Typist	82.60
