Memorandum

In exercise of the powers conferred under Article 187 (3) of the constitution of India and other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor is pleased to lay down following instructions after consultation with the speaker, West Bengal Legislative Assembly, to regulate the manner in which financial sanctions relating to the Secretariat of the Legislatures will be accorded.

1. Principal Secretary/Secretary, West Bengal Legislative Assembly Secretariat is hereby delegated with all powers under the Delegations of Financial Powers Rules, 1977, as amended, and such other financial powers as enjoyed by Principal Secretary/Secretary of an administrative Department subject to availability of fund in the budget and observance of normal financial rules and also subject to observance of economy measures adopted by the Govt. on purchase of vehicles and installation of new telephones.
2. For approved and continuing schemes, Principal Secretary/Secretary, West Bengal Legislative Assembly Secretariat is competent to release fund within budgetary provisions.
3. In case of New Schemes and for items not covered by (1) & (2) above, prior concurrence from Finance Department need be obtained.
4. All proposals which require concurrence of Finance Deptt. e.g. re-appropriation between different units within a grant shall be referred to Finance Department directly by the Secretariat of West Bengal Legislature.
5. This issues in supersession of Finance Department's G.O. No. 532-F dt. 15.2.1962.
