***Sub: Enhancement of Dearness Allowance to the members of the West Bengal Judicial Service
Serving officers and Dearness Relief to retired State Judicial officers at the revised rate enhanced
from 35% to 45% with effect from 01.07.2010.***

Sir,

I am directed by order of the Government to say that the Governor has been pleased to allow all the serving Judicial Officers of the State of West Bengal including the Higher Judicial officers in the rank of District Judges to draw the additional quantum of dearness allowance at the revised rate enhancing from the existing rate of 35% to 45% of basic pay plus, dearness pay with effect from 01.07.2010.

I am also directed to say that the Governor has further been pleased to allow the retired judicial Officers including members of Higher Judicial Service of this State to draw the dearness relief at the revised rate i.e. @ 45% of basic pension and dearness pension w.e.f. 01.07.2010.

The admissibility of the enhance rate of dearness allowance and dearness relief will, however, be as per para 2 of this department G.O. No. 14743-J dated 25.11.2004.

This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Deptt. of this Government vide their U.O. No. 3806 Gr. 'P' (Service) dated 26.10.10.
