Sub : All India Services (Medical Attendance) Rules, 1954 - delegation of powers to Controlling officers to allow refund of Medical expenses in relaxation of Rules.

Sir,

In partial modification of erstwhile Home (P&R) Deptt's earlier GO. Nos. 5109-GA/1M-36/67 dated 14.12.67, 2336-PAR(IAS) dated 24.08.77 and No. 1320- PAR(IAS) dated 21.03.1995 on the subject I am directed by order of the Governor to state that in view of the increased cost of Medicines etc. the Governor is pleased to direct that the limit of Rs. 500/- be raised to Rs. 1,000/- (Rupee one thousand) only in each case with immediate effect.

2. All other conditions shall, however, continue to remain the same as laid down in this Deptt's earlier GO. Nos., as referred to above, read with G.O. No. 777-PAR(IAS) dated 23.02.96 which stand modified to the extent as indicated herein above.
