In partial modification of erstwhile Home (P&R) Deptt's earlier GO. Nos. 5109-GA/1M-36/67 dated 14.12.67, 2336-PAR(IAS) dated 24.08.77 and No. 1320- PAR(IAS) dated 21.03.1995 on the subject I am directed by order of the Governor to state that in view of the increased cost of Medicines etc. the Governor is pleased to direct that the limit of Rs. 500/- be raised to Rs. 1,000/-(Rupee one thousand) only in each case with immediate effect.

- 2. All other conditions shall, however, continue to remain the same as laid down in this Deptt's earlier GO. Nos., as referred to above, read with G.O. No. 777-PAR(IAS) dated 23.02.96 which stand modified to the extent as indicated herein above.
