Sub: Grant of Dearness Relief of retired Judicial Officers of the Govt. of West Bengal.

In continuation of this Office Circular No. Pen Co-ordn./65 Vol. IV/24 dt. 18/05/2009 it is stated that the Govt. of West Bengal Judicial Department vide their circular letter No. 7331-J dt. 4-11-2009 have revised the rate of dearness relief to 73% w.e.f 01-07-2009 payable on basic pension/family pension and dearness pension/dearness family pension taken together to the retired Judicial officers including members of Higher Judicial Service of the State of West Bengal.

2. Payment of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
3. It shall be responsibility of the Pension Disbursing Authority including nationalized Banks etc. to calculate the quantum of dearness relief payable in each individual case.
4. All concerned Pension Disbursing Authorities are therefore requested to make necessary arrangements for payment of dearness relief to the above categories of pensioners/family pensioners (i.e. retired Judicial officers including members of Higher Judicial Service of the State of West Bengal at the rate of 73% w.e.f 01-07-2009 after proper adjustment.
