The method of, and the qualifications required for, the Special recruitment to the posts in the cadre of the West Bengal Audit and Accounts Service through the West Bengal Audit and Accounts Service (Special Recruitment) Examination, 2013, shall be as detailed below:

(1) Method of recruitment

By direct recruitment through the West Bengal Audit and Accounts Service (Special Recruitment) Examination, 2013, to be the Public Service conducted by Commission, West Bengal, in accordance with the scheme and syllabus mentioned in the ANNEXURE;

- (2) Qualifications for direct recruitment: (a) Essential: Must have Bachelor's degree in Commerce of a recognised University or must be a member of the Institute of the Chartered Accountants of India or must be a member of the Institute of Cost Accountants of India;
- the standard data the standard of the standard Computer Operation;

(3)Age for direct recruitment

Not less than twenty-one years and not more than thirty-two years on the 1st day of January of the year of advertisement. However, upper age-limit shall be relaxable for the candidates belonging to the Schedule Castes, the Schedule Tribes, the Other Backward Classes and the Persons with Disabilities as per existing rules.
