ORDER

Whereas it has been presumed by the State Government in Higher Education Department that there may remain a number of seats vacant in the Master of Computer Application (MCA) Programme of different Colleges after completion of JECA counseling 2013 conducted by the WBJEEB;

It has been decided by the State Government in Higher Education Department that the MCA seats, which may remain vacant after JECA-2013 counseling, in different AICTE approved participating Colleges of the State, offering MCA programme, be opened for admission through decentralized counseling for the JECA-2013 qualified candidates who fulfill the following AICTE norms :

1. Recognized three years Bachelors Degree with Mathematics at '10 + 2' level.
2. 50% marks (45% marks for candidates belonging to reserved categories) at the qualifying examination.

The vacancy to be filled up by the participating institutes under Decentralized counseling will be based on the vacancy statement generated by the WBJEEB for every participating institute after the completion of counseling process and published on the respective website of the WBJEE Board.

The participating Institutions shall post notice on their notice-boards and websites inviting applications from intending candidates for the said decentralized counseling and admit students on inter-se-merit as per above stated guidelines.

Further, it has been decided that the participating institutes under the Decentralized counseling process shall ensure that every candidate applying for taking admission in such vacant seats shall submit an undertaking stating that his/her candidature shall be cancelled if it is found that he/she has already taken admission at the institute allotted through the counseling process.

The cut-off date for completion of Decentralized counseling and admission at the respective participating Institute level will have to be in accordance with the academic calendar of WBUT for the academic year 2013 – 2014.

All concerned are being informed accordingly.
