**ORDER**

In compliance with the direction of the Supreme Court of India in respect of providing residential accommodation to all Judicial Officers of the State of West Bengal the Government has been pleased to lay down the following guidelines:

- i) top-most priority should be given for allotting Govt. Quarters to judicial officers ;
- ii) attempt should be made requisitioning the private house in the event Govt. accommodations are not available readily ;
- iii) attempts should be made for requisitioning the private houses which are occupied by Judicial Officers and in case, it is not possible to make such requisition of those houses/flats, the amount of rent paid by such officers for the hired houses in excess of House Rent Allowance admissible to them under normal rules would be borne by Govt. till they are provided with accommodation owned/hired by the Govt. In such cases the floor space of the hired house shall not be much in excess of the admissible limit.
