In inviting a reference to G.O. No. 10174-F, dt. 29.10.90 on the above subject the undersigned is directed to say that the Hon'ble Trial Court has since delivered its judgement on 3.6.92 on the above C. R. to the following effect.

"The writ application is dismissed. All interim orders were vacated".

- 2. By virtue of the said order of the Hon'ble Trial Court, the benefits so far enjoyed by the petitioners in terms of the G. O. No. 10174-F, dt. 29.10.90 are to be withdrawn immediately and overdrawn amounts are to be recovered.
- 3. Under the circumstances, in cancellation of the G.O. No. 10174-F, dt. 29.10.90 referred to above, the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the amount drawn by the writ petitioners so far on the basis of G. O. No. 10174-F, dt. 29.10.90 in excess of what is admissible in terms of para 8 of the Memorandum No. 432-F, dt. 12.1.90 on the W.B.S. (R.O.P.A.) Rules 1990 read with No. 2936-F, dt, 31.3.90 shall be deducted from the salary and/or from the retiring benefits of the petitioners, as the case may be immediately.
