MEMORANDUM

In Rule 8 of W.B.S. (R.O.P.A.) Rules, 1990 it has inter-alia been provided that a Government employee whose pay has been fixed in any of the revised scales of pay with a maximum of Rs. 6,700/- and below and who reaches the maximum of the scale of pay shall continue to draw increment for stagnation beyond the maximum of the scale for a period of three years at the rate last drawn by him as increment before reaching the maximum. Now a question has arisen whether such benefit will be extended to an employee who is drawing pay in a scale by virtue of Career Advancement Scheme, 1990.

Governor, after careful consideration of the matter, has been pleased to decide that whenever a Govt. employee reaches the stagnation stage in the revised scale, whether the scale of pay allowed to him is by way of normal promotion, extension of the benefit of higher scale under promotion policy or extension of the benefit under Career Advancement Scheme 1990, he is entitled to the benefit of stagnation increment(s) as per provisions of Rule 8 of W.B.S. (R.O.P.A.) Rules, 1990. So placement in the higher scale under C.A.S. shall not be any bar to admissibility of stagnation increment(s) in the higher scale.
