

Dear. Shahidul,

This is to inform you that various preparatory activities in connection with the General Elections to the Lok Sabha 2014 are going on in full swing at present in all the districts of West Bengal as per the standing instructions of the Election Commission of India. One of the important preparatory activities is the finalization of the list of Polling Stations.

As you are kindly aware, out of the 80,000 Polling booths in our State, most are located in Primary, Secondary, Higher Secondary Schools, Shishu Siksha Kendras, Madhya Siksha Kendras, Madrasahs as well as Colleges, Technical and other educational institutions.

The Election Commission of India is specially concerned with providing the minimum infrastructure to the voters at these Polling stations during the Elections. Over the period of years and with your active co-operation, we have been able to improve the condition of the schools, colleges and other educational institutions to a great extent.

However, there is still a lot of improvement which may be done in providing the very basic infrastructure like ramp for easy access to the Polling booths by Persons with Disability, electricity, separate toilets for male and female voters, drinking water and shade for the voters.

We have already collected the reports from all the District Election Officers in this regard. The report reveals some critical gaps in the basic infrastructure at the schools, colleges and other educational institutions. A soft copy of the report, pertaining to your department is appended herewith.

I would earnestly request you to kindly go through the report and address the lack of basic infrastructure in these schools, colleges and other educational institutions from your department's resources. This may be given top most priority in view of the fact that the General Elections are round the corner.
