NOTIFICATION

The Governor is pleased, in the interest of Public Service, to upgrade the following 05 (five) posts of Additional Chief Engineer (Civil) as mentioned in Col No. 2 below in the pay band scale of Rs. 37,400 - 60,000/- with grade pay of Rs. 8,700 in P-B-5 to the 05 (five) posts of Chief Engineer (Civil) as mentioned in Col No. 3 below in the pay band scale of Rs. 37,400 – 60,000/- with grade pay of Rs. 8,900/- in P-B-5 under P.W.Deptt. :-



2. The above stated up-gradation of posts of Chief Engineer (Civil) has been made subject to the following conditions:-

- I. The posts of Chief Engineer/ Chief Government Architect shall be filled up directly by promotion from the post of Superintending Engineer/ Superintending Architect of the respective cadre in accordance with the existing recruitment rules for the said posts which will be modified in due course following due procedure.
- II. There would be no post named as Additional Chief Engineer or Additional Chief Government Architect in any wing of P.W.Dept. All remaining posts of Addl. Chief Engineer & Addl. Chief Government Architect would be downgraded to Superintending Engineer/ Superintending Architect in the respective Cadre after retirement or promotion of present incumbents holding the said posts. The posts of Addl. Chief Engineer in Civil Wing shall stand abolished simultaneously with creation of the Posts of Chief Engineer.

3. The expenditure on account of pay and allowances for the 04 (four) posts of Chief Engineer (Civil) under P.W.Dte. will be debitible under the Head of Account "2059-Public Works etc." and for 01 (one) post of Chief Engineer (Civil) under P.W. (Roads) Dte. will be debitible under the Head of Accounts "3054-Roads and Bridges etc." under Demand No. 25 from the budget of the Public Works Department.

5. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide their U.O. No.473 of group-P2 dated 03.03.2014 and with the approval of the Honourable Chief Minister for placing the matter before the Cabinet for Mention vide her order dated 04.03.2014.


