MEMORANDUM

It has come to the notice of the Government that the relevant provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 with regard to the use of Trade Certificate (s) for Motor Vehicles are not being strictly followed by the holders of such certificate (s), resulting in endangering public safety, accidents and, at times, loss of human life. It has also been observed that there is apparent laxity in enforcement of the Rules (Rule 40, Rule 41, Rule 42, Rule 43, Rule 44, Rule 45 and Rule 46) to regulate the use of Trade Certificates (TC). It is, therefore, reiterated that the existing provisions of the Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989 regulating proper and legitimate use of the Trade Certificate (s) issued by the competent authorities are strictly enforced at all levels.
