The undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor is pleased to direct that all the whole time approved employees of Statutory Bodies/Govt. Undertakings /Local Bodies etc. under the administrative control of this Department, who are in receipt of Dearness Allowance at State Government rates i.e. 75% of Band Pay and Grade Pay taken together with effect from January 1, 2016, shall draw Dearness Allowance @85% with effect from the 1st January, 2017, in terms of Finance (Audit) Department's memo no. 19[65]-F(P2) dated the 2nd January, 2017.

In case of Public Undertakings / Statutory Bodies the additional expenditure should be borne by such Undertakings / Bodies themselves out of their own resources or out of the financial assistance provided to them in the budget and that no additional financial assistance will be given to them on account of sanction of Dearness Allowance.

The undersigned is further directed to enclose a copy of the Memo No. 20-F(P2) dated the 2nd January, 2017 received from the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Govt. of West Bengal, regarding Grant of Dearness Allowance to the State Govt. employees / Teachers and non-teaching employees of Non-Govt. aided / Sponsored Educational Institutions / Employees of Statutory Bodies/Govt.
