WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the West Bengal Court-fees Act, 1970, for the purpose and in the manner hereinafter appearing:

It is hereby enacted in the Thirty-first Year of the Republic of India, by the Legislature of West Bengal, as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the West Bengal Court-fees (Amendment) Act, 1980. Short title.

2. In Schedule II to the West Bengal Court-fees Act, 1970, for number 9 and the entries relating thereto, the following number and entries shall be substituted:— Amendment of Schedule II to West Ben. Act X of 1970.

“9. Mukhtarnama, Vakalatnama or any paper signed by an advocate signifying or intimating that he is retained for a party— When presented for the conduct of any one case—
