In excercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) and clause (a) and clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 180, read with sub-section (1) of section 15 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (36 of 2003) and in supersession of this Department Notification No. 276-Power /III dated the 27th July, 2004, published in the Kolkata Gazette, Extraordinary on the 5th August, 2004, the Governor is pleased hereby to make the following rules:-

Rules

- 1. Short title, extent and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the West Bengal Electricity (fees for application for grant of license) Rules, 2005.
 - (2) They shall extend to the whole of West Bengal.
 - (3) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
 - Definitions.- (1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires.-
 - (a) "Act" means the Electricity Act, 2003;
 - (b) "section" means a section of the Act;
 - (c) "Commission" means the West Bengal Electricity Regulatory Commission constituted under sub-section (1) of section 82 of the Act;
 - (d) "financial year" means a period of twelve calendar months ending on the 31st day of March every year.
 - (2) Words and expressions used and not defined in these rules, but defined in the Act, shall have the same meanings as respectively assigned to them in the Act.
- 3. Fees for making application for grant of license.- (1) Every application made to the Commission for grant of licence under section 14 of the Act, shall be accompanied by a fee of rupee two lac which shall be remitted through demand draft in favour of the Commission.
 - (2) Every licensee shall, within the month of April of every financial year, pay to the Commission an annual fee at the rate of five paise per 100 k Wh of energy that has been transmitted or distributed or traded, as the case may be, by such licensee in the preceding financial year subject to a minimum annual fee of rupees five lac;

Provided that a licensee who has not paid the annual fee for the financial year 2005-06 shall pay such fee within one month of coming into force of these rules.
