ADDENDUM NOTIFICATION

No. 1572/4/WBBPE/2022, Dated – 19/10/2022

(Ref.: Notification No. 1572/WBBPE/2022, Dated – 29/09/2022, circulated through Website Notification on 29/09/2022 and through Newspapers published on 30/09/2022)

With reference to earlier notification vide no. 1572/WBBPE/2022 dated 29.09.2022 in regard to the conduction of Teacher Eligibility Test-2022 (TET-2022) for Classes I – V by the West Bengal Board of Primary Education (WBBPE), the WBBPE adds an additional eligibility criterion to Section (i) of the notification published earlier vide No. 1572/WBBPE/2022, dated – 29/09/2022, adhering to the relevant content of NCTE Notification No. F.No.61-1/2011/NCTE(N&S) dated 29.07.2011. The added eligibility criterion shall be read as :

‘OR

Graduation and Two Year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known)’

As one of the 5th alternative criterion with other 4 alternative criterion notified earlier.

The eligibility criterion in Section (i) should be read as under after adding all addendum :

(i) Classes I-V

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2 year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known)

OR

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 year Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.)

OR

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and having Diploma in Education (Special Education), a course recognized by the Rehabilitation Council of India (R.C.I.), shall also be considered.

OR

Graduation with at least 50% marks and Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.)

OR

Graduation and Two Year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known)

5% relaxation of marks in Senior Secondary or its equivalent examination / *in Graduation* (i.e. 45%) will be allowed for the Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Other Backward Classes (OBC-A and OBC-B), Exempted Categories (EC), Ex-Servicemen, Physically Handicapped (PH) and for DH (Death-in-harness) category candidates.

“In case of Honours Graduates the candidates having 50% marks as a whole (marks obtained in Honours papers + Pass papers) in Graduation having B.Ed. training qualification are eligible to apply for TET-2022 through online portal.”

The other terms and conditions as stated in our earlier notification will remain unaltered. The concerned candidates are requested to go through our main notification for other terms and conditions required to apply.

The facility to avail the added criterion will be available after 2-3 working days for observing the technical formalities.
