**NOTIFICATION**

No. HF/O/MA/114/4P-01/17/PT-II, Dated, Kolkata the 07th January 2019. In exercise of the power conferred by section 21 of the West Bengal State Health Services Act, 1990 (West Ben. Act VII of 1990), the Governor is hereby pleased to make the following amendment in the West Bengal Medical Education Service, West Bengal Health Service and the West Bengal Public Health-cum-Administrative Service (Placement on Trainee Reserve) Rules, 2015, (hereinafter referred to as the said rules) :-

**Amendments**

In the said rules, in rule 3, after clause (b), insert the following clauses:-

“(c) The strength of total Trainee Reserve to be allowed in each session will be ten percent (10%) of the permanent medical officers in each service as on 31st March of the respective year.

*Explanation I-* **Fresh Trainee Reserve** to be allowed for each session will be determined by deducting the number of Medical Officers who are **continuing their respective courses** as **Trainee Reserve**, from the **total number of Trainee Reserve** evaluated under the clause.

*Explanation II-* **Permanent medical officers** means medical officers who after three years of uninterrupted service as probationers have been confirmed and made permanent in their respective cadres.

(d) Only the specified number, declared by notification for each session, will be allowed to avail Trainee Reserve Facility for admission in Post Graduate courses. Prior NOC will not be issued.”
