Subject: Grant of Dearness Relief on Pension to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners of the Teaching and Non-Teaching employees of the Non-Govt. Aided/Educational Institutions (both Primary and Secondary) with effect from December 1, 2010.

In pursuance of Finance Department (Pension Branch) Memo No. 974-F (Pen) dated 26.11.2010, the undersigned is directed to state that the Governor is please to decide that the Pensioners/Family Pensioners of the Teaching and Non-Teaching Employees of Non-Government Aided Educational Institutions (both Primary and Secondary) shall draw Dearness Relief on Pension @ 35% of basic pension with effect from December 1, 2010.

- 2. Payment of relief in Pension/Family Pension involving a fraction of rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
- 3. It will now be the responsibility of the Pension Disbursing Authority to calculate the quantum of relief on Pension/Family Pension payable to each individual case.
- 4. For the purpose of payment of relief on pension sanctioned herein, the Principal Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal will issue authority to the Public Sector Banks in Kolkata and the Accountant General of Other States.
- 5. The Treasury/Sub Treasury Officers in the State will give effect to this order without the authority of the Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal.
