**Notification**

In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor is pleased hereby to, make, with immediate effect, the following amendment in the rules regulating the recruitment to the posts of Bengali Stenographer (Basic Grade) in the Secretariat Departments, Directorates and other sub-ordinate Offices under the Government of West Bengal, 1994, Published under Finance Deptt. Notification No. 10802-F dt .15.11.1994 as subsequently amended (hereinafter referred to as the said rules):-

**AMENDMENT**

In the said rules, for rule 6, substitute the following rule:

“6. Age must not be less than 18 years and must not be more than 32 years of age on the 1st day of January of the year of advertisement. The upper age limit shall be relaxable upto 5 years for an employee under the State Government holding a permanent post. There shall be no age limit for permanent Typists, Permanent Steno-Typist and Permanent Clerk-cum-Typist under the Government of West Bengal who will apply for recruitment to the posts of Bengali Stenographers (Basic Grade).”
