## **MEMORANDUM**

## Subject: Supply of daily newspapers to Ministers and the Government Officers at Government cost.

As per existing orders all Ministers/Ministers of State, Secretaries/Special Secretaries and the heads of the Directors are entitled to have not more than 8 (eight), 6 (six) and 1 (one) daily newspapers respectively at Govt. cost. The question of retain the existing number of supply of daily newspapers and the extension of this benefit to the others has been active consideration of the Govt. for sometime past.

After careful consideration of all the aspects of the matter the Governor has been pleased to decide, that unless otherwise specified in this regard the daily newspaper may be supplied in the scale noted below :

i) All Ministers/Ministers of the State will be entitled to have not more than 8 (eight) daily newspapers ;

ii) All Principal Secretaries/Secretaries/Special Secretaries will be entitled to have not more than 6 (six) daily newspaper ;

iii) All joint Secretaries will be entitled to have not more than 3 (three) daily newspapers ; and

iv) All the Heads of the Directorates will be entitled to have more than 3 (three) daily newspapers.

This order takes effect from the 1<sup>st</sup> February, 1995.
