Sub: Inclusion of wards of Secondary and Higher Secondary Teachers, Non-teaching staff for appointment on compassionate ground as teachers of Primary Schools.

The provision of appointment on compassionate ground of the wards of Secondary and Higher Secondary Teachers, Non-Teaching staff, Teachers of Primary Schools have been incorporated in the West Bengal Primary School Teachers Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2009, a copy of which is attached herewith.

Section 14 of the West Bengal Primary School Teachers' Recruitment Rules deals with the 'financial criteria of the deceased/incapacitated teachers' which will also be applicable for the family of deceased/incapacitated teachers which will also be applicable for the family of deceased/incapacitated Secondary, Higher Secondary Teachers, Non-Teaching staff etc.

The 'normal family pension' as would be admissible to the family (not the 'extraordinary family pension' admissible for first seven years after the death of the employee) in the matter of determination of the income of the family has been wrongly written in the earlier version which has been corrected in this amendment.

The procedure laid down in our Order No. 351-SE (Pry)/4A-017/94 dated 30.5.96 has to be followed. The concerned District Inspector of Schools (SE) where the teacher served last will send the deserving case along with 'income criteria' of the deceased teacher's family to the concerned Chairman of the District Primary School Council where the family of deceased teacher/non-teaching staff generally resides.
