NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the power conferred by clause (2) of article 283 of the Constitution of India, the Governor is pleased hereby to make the following amendment in the Treasury Rules, West Bengal and the Subsidiary Rules made thereunder, Volume I as subsequently amended (hereinafter referred to as the said rules):

AMENDMENT

In the said rules, for sub-rule (i) of subsidiary rule 174, substitute the following sub-rule namely:

- i) Subject to the provisions of S. R. 172, pay and allowance of all kinds claimed on behalf of deceased Government employee may be paid without the production of the usual legal authority.
 - a) If the gross amount of the claim does not exceed Rs. 10,000 under the order of the Head of the office in which the Government employee was employed at the time of his death, provided that the Head of the Office is otherwise satisfied about the right and title of the claimant; and
 - b) if the gross amount of the claim exceeds Rs. 10,000 under the order of the administrative department of the Government on execution of an indemnity bond by the claimant(s), duly stamped for double the gross amount due for payment, with two surities as may be deemed necessary:

Provided that subject to the provision of clause (a), the Head of the Office may make anticipatory payment of an amount not exceeding Rs. 10,000.
