NOTIFICATION

No. H/MA/1503/JS-II/90. — 30th May 1990. — In exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (2) of section 9 and sub-section (1) of section 17 of the West Bengal State Health Service Act, 1990 (West Ben. Act VII of 1990), the Governor is pleased hereby to make with effect from the 25th day of May, 1990 the following rules:

- 1. These rules may be called the West Bengal Medical Education Service (Pay and Allowances) Rules, 1990.
- 2. The scales of pay of persons appointed to the following teaching posts in the West Bengal Medical Education Service (hereinafter referred to as the W.B.M.E.S) shall be as follows:
- i) Professor—Rs. 4,500-150-5,700-200-7,300/-
- ii) Associate Professor—Rs, 4,000-125—4,500-150-6,000/-
- iii) Reader—Rs. 3,700-125-4,950-150-5,700/-
- iv) Assistant Professor—Rs. 3,000-100-3,500-125-5,700/-
- v) Lecturer (Basic Scale)—Rs. 2,200-80-3,000-100-4,000 initial starting from Rs. 2680/-
- vi) Lecturer (Senior Scale)—Rs. 3,000-100-3,500-125-5,700/-
- vii) Basic Teacher—Rs. 2,200-80-3,0000-100-4000/-
- 3. The pay of a Lecturer either appointed through the State Public Service Commission or belonging to existing West Bengal Health Service who opts for the W.B.M.E.S. shall be fixed automatically in the following:

| Pay Scales | Eligible Lecturers |

| i) Rs. 2,200-80-3,000-100-4,000 with higher initial starting at Rs. 2,680 per month (Basic scale-Lecturer). | Following the appointment through the State Public Service Commission as Lecturer in the basic scale of W.B.M.E.S. |
| ii) Rs. 3,000-100-3,500-125- 5,700 (Senior scale of Lecturer). | West Bengal Health Service having less than 5 years of service after Post graduation who opt for the W.B.M.E.S and subsequently appointed as Lecturer in the W.B.M.E.S. |

A Lecturer who has completed / will complete 5 years of service will be placed in the Senior scale (Rs. 3,000-5,700). For this purpose, service will be counted from the date of obtaining Post graduate degree or equivalent degree.

4. Persons appointed in the W.B.M.E.S. shall receive non-practising allowance according to the norms laid down below:

| Basic pay | Admissible rates (p/m) |

| i) From Rs. 2,000 to Rs. 2,900 per month | Rs. 600 |
| ii) From Rs. 3,000 to Rs. 3,699 per month | Rs.850 |
| iii) From Rs. 3,700 to Rs. 5,999 per month | Rs.950 |
| iv) Rs. 6,000 and above per month | Rs.1,000 |

- 5. The non-practising allowance as aforsaid shall be considered as "Nonpractising Pay" for all service matters and shall be taken into account for computing D. A. entitlement of TA/DA. Retirement Benefits and House Building Loans. However, the pay plus Non-Practising Pay shall not exceed Rs. 8.000 per month.
- 6. The Pay and Allowance of all persons appointed in the W.B.M.E.S. shall be governed by the provisions of the West Bengal Health Service (Cadre, Pay and Allowance) Rules, 1958 as amended from time to time and the West Bengal Services (Revisions of Pay and Allowances) Rules, 1990 and such other orders as may be issued by the Government from time to time.
- 7. Persons opting for the W.B.M.E.S. and subsequently appointed as teachers in the W.B.M.E.S. shall have the option of retaining the pay scale and other allowances as admissible to them immediately before the coming into force of these rules till such time as may be declared by them while exercising the option for the scale of pay of the W.B.M.E.S.
