**Subject: Implementation of the West Bengal Health Scheme, 2008—**  
**completion of enrolment within 31.12.2010**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Finance Department's Notification No. 8014-F (MED) dt. 30-07-10 and Memo No. 8016-F (MED) dt. 30-07-10 on the above subject and to request you to complete enrolment under the West Bengal Health Scheme, 2008 within 31-12-10 following the above orders and provisions of the Scheme

In the meantime Government issued another Memorandum No. 10795-F (MED) dt. 22-11-10 liberalizing the enrolment procedures of the pensioners who are residing far away from their last place of posting. Those pensioners may enroll their names under the Health Scheme in their departmental district office or under the District Magistrate in which he/she is residing. Pensioners residing in Kolkata and whose last place of posting was at a distant place may, however, enroll their names in the Directorate office in Kolkata.

As the time is very short now, you are requested to take up the job on war footing basis so that the process of enrolment may be completed within 31-12-10. It may kindly be ensured that the pending applications for enrolment are disposed of within 31-12-10 otherwise confusion may start arising after the stipulated date is over.
