### MEMORANDUM

In view of queries from some corners regarding age and suitability of retired employees from other departments for re-employment in terms of this Department's Memo No.10935-F(P) dated 05-12-2011, the undersigned is directed to clarify as follows:-

1. Re-employment shall not be granted beyond the age of 65 years of age under any circumstances. Thus, the age of a retired employee should not exceed 64 years on the scheduled date of joining.
2. As the entire purpose of re-employment is to utilize the domain of expertise of the retired employees, it would be better to re-employ retired employees from the concerned department to avoid training involving additional posts. However, in case of shortage, retired employees of other departments may be considered if they are found suitable to perform the job.
